Crypt's Activity Mission

After watching Episode 1, go to a familiar place - a yard, porch, garden, sidewalk, schoolyard, or window view. Look for something natural that you normally pass without noticing. It might be a leaf, bark pattern, bug, root, seed, bird sound, shadow, cloud, moss patch, or tiny plant pushing through the ground.

1. Notice	Find three natural details you had not noticed before.
2. Wonder	Choose one detail and write a question about it.
3. Connect	How might this detail be connected to another living thing?
4. Act	Take one small helpful action: leave a natural area undisturbed, pick up litter, water a dry plant with permission, or tell someone what you noticed.
